RESPECTIVE FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS AND PRINCIPAL IN RELATION TO ADMISSIONS

The Board of Governors draws up the admissions criteria and delegates to the Principal, the responsibility for applying these criteria. Any reference herein to the term the Board of Governors includes the Principal appointed by the Board of Governors for the purposes of applying the admissions criteria.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

During the admissions procedure when applying the criteria <u>punctual applications</u> will be considered before <u>late applications</u> are considered. The application procedure opens on 10 January 2022 at 12noon (GMT) and an application submitted by the closing date of 28 January 2022 at 12noon (GMT) will be treated as a <u>punctual application</u>. An application received after 12noon (GMT) on 28 January 2022 will be treated as a <u>late application</u>.

The Principal will apply the following criteria in the order indicated to identify which children should be admitted either at initial admission to education or on transfer from another school.

- 1 Children of compulsory school age who normally live in the Ballinderry Parish.
- 2 Children who, at the date of their application, have a child of the family currently enrolled at the school.
- 3 Children whose brothers and sisters, half-brothers/half-sisters previously attended the school.
- 4 Sons or daughters of permanent full-time employees at the school.
- 5 Children for whom the school is the Catholic Maintained primary school nearest to their home. For purposes of measuring we will use Google Maps UK.
- 6 Children outside the Ballinderry Parish whose parents/guardians previously attended the school.
- 7 Children outside the Ballinderry Parish with special circumstances (social, medical or security). The special circumstances must be made known at the time of the application.
- The remaining places will be allocated on the basis of the proximity of the child's home* to the school, priority being given to those living nearest to the school. Distance from home will be measured using Google Maps UK.

If the final places to be allocated have identical measurements as identified by Google Maps UK, selection will be on the initial letter of surname (as entered on birth certificate) in the order set out below:

PQHTGVSZOFUYMBKCRJIDWXLANE

In the event of surnames beginning with the same letter the subsequent letters of the surname will be used in alphabetical order. In the event of two identical surnames the alphabetical order of the initial of the forename will be used, and if necessary the subsequent letters of the forenames.

^{*}Home is the child's permanent place of residence. It is not the child-minders or a relative's address.

DUTY TO VERIFY

Applicants should note that they may be required to produce documents verifying their address. This is in addition to the standard requirement to provide a birth certificate in order to demonstrate whether or not a child is of compulsory school age. The provision of false or incorrect information or the failure to provide verifying documents according to the required deadline may result in either the withdrawal of a place or the inability of a primary school to offer a place.

WAITING LIST POLICY

For the admission of Year 1 children with the appropriate age after the beginning of the school year, and when the school does not exceed its enrolment number, the criteria used for selecting between applicants will be the same as Year One entry.

ADMISSION TO P2 - P7

The following criteria will be applied in the order set down 1-2

- 1. A pupil will be considered for enrolment provided that the school will not exceed its enrolment number determined by the Department of Education and
- 2. In the opinion of the Board of Governors their admission would not prejudice the efficient use of the school's resources.
