Swimming Lessons

Swimming lessons for the P7 pupils will finish on Wednesday 30th March. P5 pupils will commence their swimming lessons on Wednesday 5th April for eight weeks at the Greenvale Leisure Centre, Magherafelt finishing on Wednesday 1st June. A fee of £3.50 per child covers the cost of swimming lessons and transport. A permission slip will be issued via Private Messaging for all parents/guardians to confirm their child's participation.

ECO Schools - Battery Recycling

Derrychrin PS are now a collection point for disposing of used batteries. When batteries are disposed of with general household waste they end up in landfill. As they begin to rot away the chemicals contained in these batteries can seep into the ground causing soil and water pollution which can have a detrimental effect on our environment.

Recycling batteries not only helps to conserve our environment, it also means the materials making up the batteries can be repurposed and reused to create new products.

Our recycling point is located at the front reception of the school. You can send batteries (sealed in a small bag) in with the children to recycle or you can drop them in at reception.

Our ECO School team will continue to monitor the recycling initiative as part of their action plan for this year.



Payment of Dinner Money

Safer Schools NI App

A new safeguarding app, 'Safer Schools NI' is now available to parents and carers in Northern Ireland. The Safer Schools app has been offered to the Department of Education by the iNEQE Safeguarding Group', run by Jim Gamble. As a parent and carer, the Safer Schools NI App will help you to navigate the digital world that your children and young people live in every day. It will help by giving you the tools to protect the children and young people in your care online. We ask that all parents download the app to their smart device. A separate letter with more information / download instructions has been issued to all parents. Additional information is available in our 'Safeguarding' section on our school website.

Neuronimo

The Neuronimo programme is a children and young person's mental and physical health programme. It is delivered by a children's charity called Reverse The Trend Foundation in partnership with the Education Authority. Reverse The Trend Foundation uses evidence-based neuroscience to promote mental wellness in our children. It does not rely on short-term fixes such as limiting screen time. Instead, the Neuronimo programme uses evidence supported by University partners to change behaviour and create healthy habits around mental and physical health.

Our pupils will complete short, fun, goal-orientated tasks over a period of 12 weeks with their teacher in school. During the programme they are supported online by Neuronimo Ambassadors who help create healthy habits. The tasks can be as short as 3-4 minutes for mental health tasks or 15 minutes for physical activity tasks.

The Neuronimo programme is also available for use at home with a home link for parents and P5-P7 pupils. This is an opportunity to supplement any Neuronimo learning in school. The Home Access is not compulsory but we do encourage it where possible. The link for Neuronimo at home is unique to Derrychrin Primary School. The link will take parents and P5-P7 pupils to the Learning Management System where they will be prompted to sign up and create a log-in. This will give them access to selected course material. Each parent and pupil will have an individual log-in so they can move through the course at their preferred pace allowing for inset days, holidays etc.
